### PHOTOS :

(1) Blue: 40ML

Old Holland Cyan Blue

OR

Prussian Blue (any professional artist grade)

(1) Yellow: 40ML

Cadmium Yellow Light-genuine cadmium, not a hue! (any professional artist grade)

(1) Red: 40ML

Quinacridone Magenta (any professional artist grade)

(1) White: 150ML

Titanium White

(any professional artist grade)

(1) Black: 40ML

Ivory Black (any professional artist grade)

#### II. Mediums:

(1)Solvent: Eco House #125 Neutral Thin, Eco-Solve *or* Gamsol

**(1) 4oz. Linseed *or* Stand *or* Walnut Oil**

**(1) 4oz. Graham Walnut Alkyd Medium**

## **III. Brushes:**

**\*Hog Bristle Brushes sizes 6-20 assorted shapes: rounds, filberts, flats  
(Silverbrush or other good brand)**

**(1) Kolinsky Sable round #4 or #6**

**(1) 4" wide inexpensive flat china bristle  
gesso brush**

**(1) Pallet Knife (elongated diamond shape 2-3in. blade)**

## **Acrylic Painter's Materials List**

### **I. Paints:**

- (1) Blue: 2oz. Tube**  
Primary Cyan (Golden) or Prussian Blue (any professional artist grade)
- (1) Yellow: 2oz. Tube**  
Cadmium Yellow Light-genuine cadmium, not a hue! (any professional artist grade)
- (1) Red: 2oz. Tube**  
2oz tube Quinacridone Magenta (any professional artist grade)
- (1) White: 5oz Tube**  
Titanium-Zinc (any professional artist grade)
- (1) Black: 2oz. Tube**  
Ivory Black (any professional artist grade)

### **II. Mediums:**

- (1) 4oz. Golden Acrylic Glazing Liquid (Satin or Gloss)**
- (1) 4oz. Golden Retarder**
- (1) 4oz. Golden Polymer Medium (Gloss)**

### **III. Brushes:**

- \*Hog Bristle Brushes sizes 6-20 assorted shapes: rounds, filberts, flats (Silverbrush or other good brand)**
- (1) 4" wide inexpensive flat china bristle brush**
- (1) Pallet Knife (elongated diamond shape 2-3in. blade)**
