Acrylic Painting II Materials List:

- Water cup (this doesn't need to be fancy. Any recycled plastic container will do)
- Pencil for quick sketches
- One canvas board or pre-stretched canvas 16" x 20"
- 1-2 additional canvas boards or pre-stretched canvases 16"x20" or larger
- Small pad of Canvas Paper or Bristol Board for in class exercises
- Ruler
- Eraser
- Acrylic Paint: Bring what you have!
*Purchase whatever your budget will allow but a non-student grade paint will serve you better in the long run.
- Paint brushes – small set with a variety of sizes – Stick with rounds and flats (you can get any type but synthetic bristles will hold up better with acrylics)
- One larger brush – 1.5" – 2"
- Medium flexible metal Palette knife
- Palette (can be glass, plastic, or palette paper – flat surface – not the kind with cups for paint to sit in)
- Rags (old t-shirts work well)
- Small Spray Bottle
- Hand Soap – liquid not bar (can share)
- Toolbox to hold all supplies
- Apron or shirt to wear while painting (optional)

In this class, we will experiment with some other acrylic mediums in our paintings. If you have any already, please bring them as well. (gel medium, matte medium, molding paste, image transfers, etc.) These can be a bit pricey so I will have some in class that you can try before buying.
* There will be an additional \$5 material fee paid to the instructor for use of acrylic mediums
