Qty	Tools/Materials	Notes
1-2	Primed Canvas or hardboard 11" x 14" or larger	Or bring pieces in progress
1	2 - 5 oz Heavy Body Golden Acrylic Quinacridone Crimson or Primary Magenta	These colors are suggestions, the important thing is to have artist quality heavy body acrylics. You should have at least a red, white, blue, and yellow.
1	2 - 5 oz Heavy Body Golden Acrylic Phthalo Blue (Green shade or Red shade)	
1	2 - 5 oz Heavy Body Golden Acrylic Hansa Yellow Medium or Benzimidazolone Yellow Medium	
1	5 oz or larger Heavy Body Golden Acrylic Titanium White	
2-3	metal palette knives in different shapes and sizes. My favorite is the Bob Ross Palette Knife No. 5	Jerry's Artarama Website or amazon
1	Paint Mixing Palette. (I like to use the disposable type)	
1	Flat paint brush ½" - 1" wide (does not need to be an expensive brush.)
