Thank you for your interest in our ArtsCamps for Summer 2025! Please see below for a few notes on the catalog and registration dates.

- Registration for ArtsCamp 2025 will open to the public on Monday, January 13th at 9:00AM

- The catalog is organized by week and the dates of each week are noted at the top of each page
 - Within each week, you will see camps organized by age group (K-2nd, 3rd-5th, and 6th-9th)
- There are AM and PM sessions for each age group
 - The AM session runs from 9:00-12:00
 - The PM session runs from 1:00-4:00
 - There are Lunch care options (free) and Before and/or AfterCare options (\$25 each) for all campers, which can be selected when registering
- The cost of one half-day camp for one week is \$220 (\$440 for a full day)
 - There is no camp on June 19th or July 4th and the price of those weeks of camp is prorated to reflect the missing day of camp.
