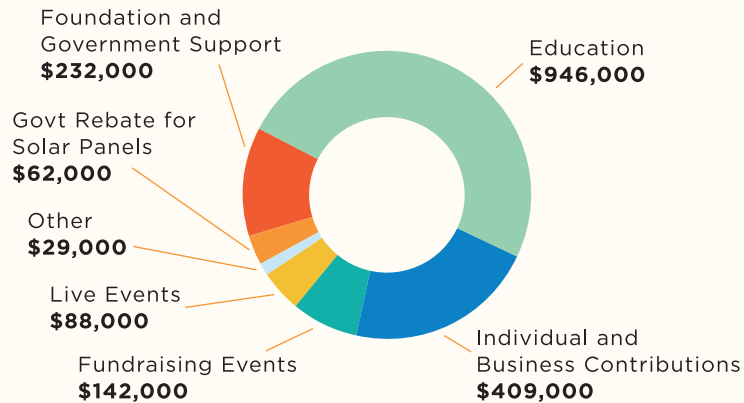

2024 TOTAL EXPENSES: \$2,111,500

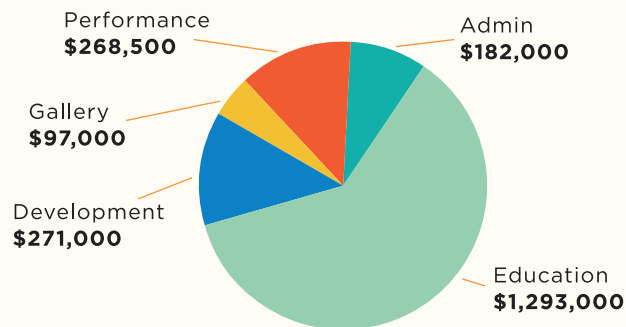

GENERATED \$5M OF ECONOMIC IMPACT AND CREATED 94 JOBS IN ORANGE COUNTY

Every class taken, every performance attended, every camper engaged has a big impact on our local economy. The impact starts with giving a working artist a job! We employed 295 artists in 2024. Patrons and artists, alike, also patronize local businesses while in our downtown. The monies spent generate government revenue which helps drive community development and economic growth.

AWARDED \$49,359 IN SCHOLARSHIPS

Despite a decrease in government funding, we held true to our commitment to expand access to the arts. We awarded 11% more financial assistance than in the previous year.

NOW IN ITS 15TH YEAR, OUR ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM ENGAGED 2,196 STUDENTS IN THE ARTS

Each year, we partner with the Orange County School District to integrate the arts into the curriculum at Title One Schools ensuring arts access and academic success for under-resourced youth in our community.
